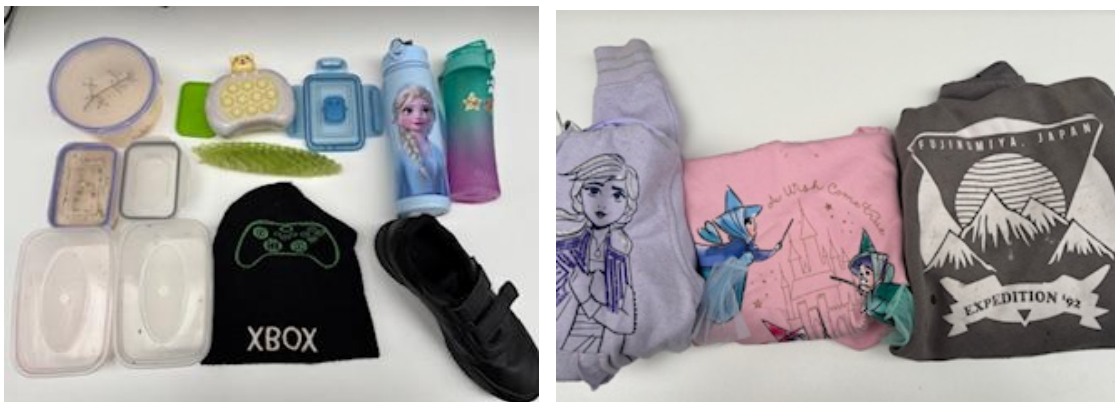
### [Y3-6 Cross Country Training](#)
